



Polperro Community Council has vacancies for

Community Enforcement Officers

to monitor and control dog behaviour in the village of Polperro and the surrounding area.

The role will include patrolling the predetermined area, engaging with dog owners, and issuing of advice, warnings or fixed penalty notices where appropriate. The role will also encompass littering issues.

The role is part time and flexibility of available working hours is essential in order to provide the correct level of patrols. Hours will vary by season on a rota basis. The role attracts a very competitive hourly rate. Previous experience of enforcement work is welcome though not essential as full training will be provided. There are two posts available.
