7. New proxy vote applications must be sent to the Electoral Registration Officer by not later than 5pm on **Tuesday 27 April, 2021**.
8. New applications to vote by proxy on grounds of a medical emergency or absence in relation to occupation, employment or service occurring after 5pm on 27 April 2021, must be sent to the Electoral Registration Officer by not later than 5pm on Thursday 6 May, 2021.
All applications and notices regarding absent voting must be sent to the **Electoral Registration Officer, 3S, County Hall, Truro TR1 3AY**.
