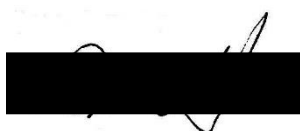
4 Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting held on Monday 19th November 2018.

PA18/10688	Seaview Holiday Village Polperro Road	Extension and improvements to Seaview Holiday Village caravan park, comprising use of land for the siting of additional lodges/caravans (static caravans) for holiday use; access and parking, landscape planting and associated infrastructure (Revised Application to PA17/09558 dated 09/02/18).	0F/10A/1 AWAY
PA18/10833	Sundale The Coombes Polperro	Improvement of existing raised patio and access steps. Works include; uplifting crazy paving, grading the surface to create a level area and improve access, laying millboard decking, with stone retaining walls and compliant access steps. Demolish existing rear extension, rebuild extension on same footprint using comparable materials and Improve access to the front drive by widening the bridge crossing the stream.
